Tee Booking

To book a tee time you must know your Tee Booking System Username, which is normally your club "Record ID", a number that should be shown on your fee notice. The club office can assist with this.

Before using the system you must set a password for yourself. This can be done as follows:

1. On your Browser, open the Club Website at www.largsgolfclub.co.uk
2. Under the Menu Heading "The Course" click "Book a Tee Time", then "Book Now" (under "Member On-Line Booking") then "Book a Tee Time" (NB. Please do NOT use the "Click Here to Register" option).
3. On the Login Screen, click on "Forgot Password". This will send an email to you inviting you to set a password. Click on the link in the email then follow the on-screen instructions to set up your password.

Once you have set up a password, follow steps 1 & 2 above to login.

INTRODUCTION OF GUESTS

Members may introduce up to seven guests at any one time to use the clubhouse facilities. Failure to do so could result in the club losing its licence.

Membership Cards

Members may use their Pre-Payment cards for the purchase of drinks and catering. Drinks purchased by this method attract a 5% discount on the published cash price. Member accounts can be topped up at any time at the bar either with cash or using the debit/credit card (the 3% charge applies for all transactions by credit card). The minimum top up amount is £10.

At the end of the subscription year any unused balance of the initial pre-payment charge is automatically forfeited, but unused amounts from top ups remain credited for the following year.

Fixtures and Events Diary

A Fixtures and Events booklet is issued annually and it includes comprehensive details about the club together with a copy of the club's constitution and rules and bye-laws. It should contain all the information needed to actively participate in and benefit from the full use of the club.

Handicaps

In order to obtain a handicap you will have to submit three scores, one of which must be from the Medal Tees. Each scorecard must be signed by a member who already holds a full handicap. Supplementary

Scores, booked in beforehand at the Professionals shop, can also count as medal rounds for this purpose.

In order to retain your handicap it is necessary to return a minimum of three strokeplay scores each year (non-returns do not count).

Club Competitions

The club runs a large number and variety of competitions throughout the year, details of which are included in the Fixtures and Events booklet and, provided you have a handicap, you are encouraged to participate in these.

Entry to the annual knockout competitions is made at the beginning of the year. Keep an eye on the noticeboards in the clubhouse for the entry sheets.

Full details of all competitions and the rules of entry are included in the folder to the left of the competitions noticeboard in the main corridor.

“Manic Monday”

Most Mondays, weather permitting, there is an informal “roll up” group (Manic Monday) that meet in the lounge at around 10: – 10:30am. A draw is made for playing partners before battle commences on the course with some “friendly”, but competitive, golf. New and long standing members are welcome to come along. It’s a great way for new members to meet people and for “old” members to meet new players.

Medals

Medals are normally played on Wednesdays and Saturdays. For the latest information on booking arrangements please refer to the club website members page at <http://www.largsgolfclub.co.uk/the-club/discover/member-s-page.html>

Playing Guests

Members (including juniors) are allowed to sign in up to three playing guests at a time. Bookings should be made through the Professional and the appropriate Member/Guest fee paid. No guest is allowed to play the course on more than six occasions in any calendar year.

Social

The club runs a variety of social events to suit all tastes and details are advertised on the clubhouse noticeboards and by email. Members are encouraged to support these events and booking should be made at the bar.

To help with its fund-raising efforts, the Club also runs a 100 Club. There are 11 regular monthly draws with 4 prizes - £75, £50 and 2 x £25. The December draw is for £750, £70, 2 x £30. The monthly subscription for this is £5. Full details are in the Fixtures and Events booklet (p13). Please contact the Secretary if you wish to join.

Dress Code

The club operates a relaxed dress code, details of which are included in the Fixtures and Events booklet and on notices posted in the clubhouse. Members are requested to ensure that they adhere to these regulations and staff have been instructed to ensure that it is enforced.

Insurance

All players are advised to arrange their own golf insurance.

Payment Facilities

The Club operates a Direct Debit facility for the payment of subscriptions and all other fees. The scheme runs for 12 months each year though, for new members, it can be joined at any point during the year. There is a small additional charge, set by committee, for use of the DD facility.

Payment can also be made in cash, by cheque, by credit card (a 3% charge is applied), debit card (no charge) or bank transfer (Sort Code 82 66 05 Account: 30017799)

Equipment Rental

During the playing season the club has battery operated buggies available for rent at a cost of £10 per round.
